

Battery Handling for Blue Star Recyclers' Customers



Due to the fire hazard involved with the storage and transportation of loose batteries, Blue Star Recyclers now requires all battery terminals/contacts to be taped (both terminals). This applies only to **loose batteries**. Exposed terminals on a battery, when in contact with another non-taped battery can cause a fire during storage and/or transportation.

Note: The tape must be a **clear tape**; other types of tapes such as masking, duct, electrical, or gaffer tape are not acceptable.

There is an exception to this rule: alkaline batteries do not need to be taped.

Batteries that are not taped or are taped with an incorrect type of tape will incur a taping surcharge of **\$4.25 per pound**.
